HOW TO DO IT:

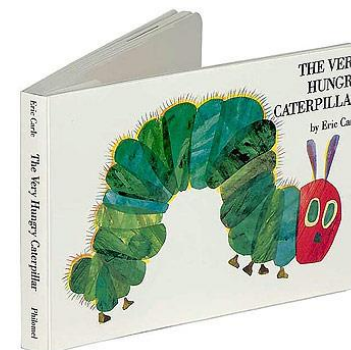
- Introducing the story (Mystery Box)

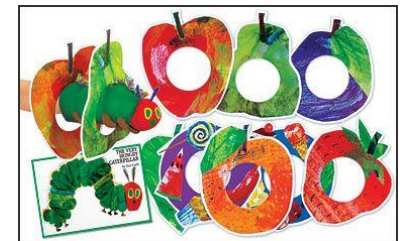

- Count the different types of fruits and food and write it down

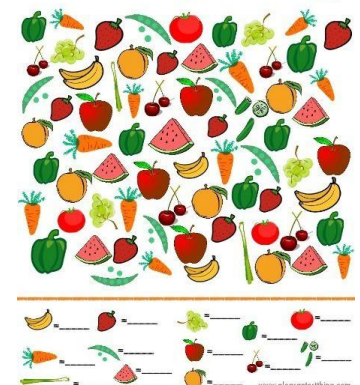

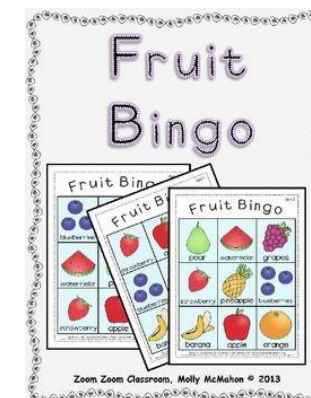

HOW TO DO IT:

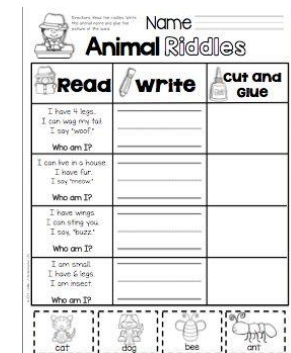
- Stick the animal's flashcards on the whiteboard
